

Two Mormon elders, Ralph S. Hunt and B. W. Dansie, from Weber, Utah, called at the Chronicle office last Saturday, and we held a long interview with them, which we may publish in a more extended form in a week or two. These “Latter Day Saints,” as they call themselves, are very plausible in stating their religious belief, particularly Elder Hunt, who does nearly all of the talking. They deny that plurality of wives is any part of their teachings, and claim that their religion is founded on the Bible and the Book of Mormon, both of which are held to be the word of God. They announce the intention of performing “missionary work” in Grant parish for two or three months this summer, and expect to “preach” for us here in Colfax at some early date.
